

### The evolution of Egyptian food exports from 2020 to 2024 Value in billion dollars







• Total exports in 2024 amounted to \$ 6.1 billion, a growth of 21% compared to exports of the same period of 2023 of \$ 5.1 billion



# Food exports to international groups in 2024 compared to 2023 Value in million US dollars










## Exports to the top 15 importing countries in 2024 compared to 2023 (value in million US dollars)





# Exports of the most important commodities of the food industry in 2024 compared to 2023 (value in million dollars)







### Egyptian Processed Food Exports to the European Union, 2020–2024






In 2024, the European Union accounted for about 19% of Egypt's processed food exports, with a total value of USD 1.2 billion out of USD 6.1 billion.



### Egyptian Processed Food Exports to the Top 10 European Countries by Value in 2024






These ten countries accounted for about 91% of Egypt's food exports to the European Union in 2024, with a total value of USD 1.1 billion out of USD 1.2 billion.



### Top 15 Egyptian Food Products Exported to the European Union in 2024






These products represent about 83% of Egypt's total exports to the European Union, with a total value of USD 964 million out of USD 1.16 billion.





#### **Yearly Growth Trends from Egypt to Germany (2020-2024)**








#### **Top 10 Products Egypt Exported to Germany in 2024**





These products account for about 88% of Egypt's total exports to Germany, with a total value of USD 116 million out of a total of USD 132 million.



#### Egypt's Top Growing Food Exports to EU in H1 2025





These products represent about 83% of Egypt's total exports to the European Union, with a total value of USD 964 million out of USD 1.16 billion.



### Why Sourcing from Egypt



- Egypt's location allows for smooth trade through the Suez Canal and multiple Mediterranean and Red Sea ports. A vast land transport network further supports exports to North Africa and the Arabian Gulf.
- Egypt leads the Arab and Middle Eastern food export markets, reaching \$6.1 billion in processed food exports in 2024 to 179 international markets, This marks a 21% growth from 2023's \$5.1 billion in processed food exports, alongside \$4.7 billion in agricultural exports.
- The establishment of the National Food Safety Authority nearly **six**years ago has had a positive impact on the growth of Egyptian

  food exports in accordance with global technical and health
  requirements.





### Why Sourcing from Egypt



- Globally, Egypt ranks **42<sup>nd</sup>** among food exporters with **a 0.48**% market share. Regionally, it ranks **2<sup>nd</sup>** in Africa and **1<sup>st</sup>** among Arab countries. Egypt is also the largest producer and manufacturer of food products among Arab nations in 2024.
- Arab countries are the largest buyers of Egyptian food products. In 2024, Saudi Arabia imported \$491 million worth of processed food, followed by Sudan (\$412 million) and Libya (\$333 million).
- The **US ranked 4th** among Egypt's export markets, importing **\$330 million** in food products. In the EU, Italy, Spain, and the Netherlands were top destinations.
- Soft drink concentrates (\$532 million), flour, starch, grits, and malt (\$464 million), sugar (\$381 million), and frozen strawberries (\$381 million) are Egypt's leading food exports.
- Egypt is the world's largest exporter of frozen strawberries, supplying **80** markets with a **26% global share**. And In 2023/2024, Egypt was the world's top producer of table olives, with an estimated production of **650,000 tons**.
- Egypt benefits from its participation in the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA), which became operational on **January 1, 2021**.

  Under the agreement, Least Developed Countries (LDCs) will eliminate tariffs on **90% of goods over 10 years**, targeting **0%** tariffs by **2031**. This enhances Egypt's access to African markets and strengthens its role as a regional trade hub.
