• This category includes various tomato-based products such as tomato paste, puree, sauce, and tomato concentrate. These products are essential in culinary applications, ranging from making pasta sauces and soups to being used as condiments and ingredients in processed foods.

Introduction

This report examines the global demand for prepared or preserved tomatoes, with a particular emphasis on Egypt's export potential in this industry. Our analysis centers on HS code 200290, which had a global export value of 5.2 billion USD in 2023. Another related category, Tomato Ketchup and Other Tomato Sauces (HS code 210320) had a global export value of 2.6 billion USD in 2023.


In 2023, Egypt's exports under HS code 200290 amounted to 92 million USD and 65 thousand tons in volume. Meanwhile, under HS code 210320 Egypt exported \$82 million in value and 57 thousand tons in volume. Our report is centered on HS code 200290.

Does Egypt have growth opportunities in the tomato prepared and preserved sector (HS code 200290)? Which countries offer the greatest potential for expanding Egypt's exports in this product category?


Global Imports and Trend Analysis

Global Import Quantities from 2014 to 2023(in Million ton)




During the examination of global imports and trends, it was observed that the total import value for 2023 amounted to 5 billion USD, accompanied by a corresponding quantity of 3.3 million tons. Between 2019 and 2023, import values demonstrated an annual growth rate of 18%, while import quantities showed an annual growth of 4%, suggesting an upward trajectory in prices throughout this timeframe.

Analysis of Global Imports and Trends from Q1 2020 to Q2 2024













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EGYPTIAN EXPORT MARKET SHARE BY COUNTRY IN 2023 GOEIC DATA







Key findings

The markets with greatest potential for Egypt's exports of 200290 Tomatoes, prepared/preserved, n.e.s. are Libya, Iraq and Saudi Arabia. 



China and Turkey collectively dominate Iraq's market for prepared or preserved tomatoes, commanding a combined 98% share in import value. These dynamics highlight China's overwhelming dominance in Iraq's market, driven by robust growth and competitive pricing, while Turkey faces challenges in maintaining its foothold due to recent economic conditions impacting export competitiveness.



Conclusion



- The global demand for prepared or preserved tomatoes, specifically under HS code 200290, reached \$5 billion, with an annual growth rate of 18% in value and 4% in volume between 2019 and 2023. In 2023, Egypt's exports under this HS code totaled \$92 million and 65 thousand tons, with an annual growth in value of 59% from 2022 to 2023.
- Key importers in 2023 included Germany, the UK, Iraq, Japan, Italy, the Netherlands, and France, collectively representing approximately 44% of global imports. Germany accounted for 11%, the UK 7%, Iraq and Japan 6% each, and Italy, the Netherlands, and France 5%, 5%, and 4%, respectively.
- Key exporters in 2023 were China, Italy, Spain, and Portugal, which collectively accounted for 69% of global exports. China held 27%, Italy 25%, Spain 10%, and Portugal 7%. Egypt contributed 2% of global exports, ranking 8th globally. Egypt's exports grew significantly between 2019 and 2023, with an annual value growth rate of 80% and a volume growth rate of 59%.
- According to the Export Potential Map, the markets with the greatest potential for Egypt's exports of prepared/preserved tomatoes (HS code 200290) are Libya, Iraq, and Saudi Arabia. Libya shows the largest absolute difference between potential and actual exports, leaving room to realize additional exports worth \$31 million.

Conclusion following



- In Libya, which accounted for 2.2% of the world's imports for prepared or preserved tomatoes and ranked 12th globally in 2023, the market experienced a 9% growth in value and a -2% decline in volume from 2019 to 2023. The top exporters to Libya were Italy (77%), Tunisia (12%), the USA (5%), and Egypt (3%). Egypt exhibited the most remarkable growth, with exports to Libya growing by 188% in value and 156% in volume annually from 2019 to 2023. From 2022 to 2023 alone, Egypt's exports to Libya increased by 225% in value. The unit value of Egyptian exports was \$1,627 per ton.
- In Iraq, the third-largest importer of prepared or preserved tomatoes (accounting for 6.2% of global imports), the market grew by 35% in value and 30% in volume between 2019 and 2023. The top exporters to Iraq were China (64%) and Turkey (34%), commanding a combined 98% of the market share. These dynamics highlight China's dominance in Iraq, driven by robust growth and competitive pricing.
- The Saudi Arabian market, which accounted for 2% of world imports for HS code 200290 in 2023 and ranked 14th globally, experienced a 17% growth in value and a 6% growth in volume between 2019 and 2023. From 2022 to 2023, imports into Saudi Arabia increased by 79% in value. Leading exporters to Saudi Arabia were China (68%), Chile (7%), Portugal (7%), and Turkey (6%), while Egypt accounted for 3% of the market share. Egypt demonstrated significant growth, with an annual increase of 421% in value and 213% in volume, and a 400% rise from 2022 to 2023, establishing itself as a competitive player in the Saudi market.
