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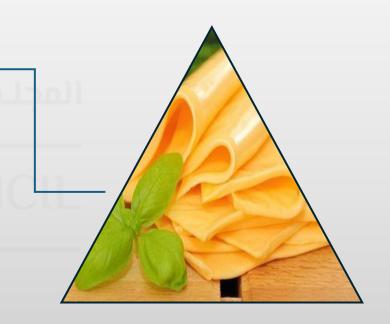


Product Overview

Product Name: Processed cheese not grated or powdered.

HS Code: 040630

Processed cheese, also known as prepared cheese, cheese product, or cheese food, is a category of cheese products made by combining and melting natural cheeses along with emulsifiers, additional dairy ingredients, and sometimes other food additives. Unlike natural cheeses, which are directly derived from milk through processes like coagulation and aging, processed cheese undergoes a specific manufacturing process to achieve its distinctive characteristics.



Introduction

This report highlights the promising global market for processed cheese (not grated or powdered), with a focus on Egypt's export potential under HS code 040630. The global export value for this product reached \$3.7 billion, with 632 thousand tons traded worldwide.

According to GOEIC data, Egypt exported \$156 million and 43 thousand tons of processed cheese products under HS Codes 040630, 040690, and 210690. This includes \$68 million under HS Code 0406 and \$87 million under HS Code 210690 (Vegetable Fat Cheese Preparations).

The report aims to explore whether Egypt can expand its foothold in this market and identify countries with the most potential for increased market share. Detailed analysis will uncover where Egypt can leverage its production capabilities and target new growth opportunities in global markets.

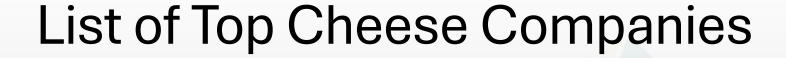

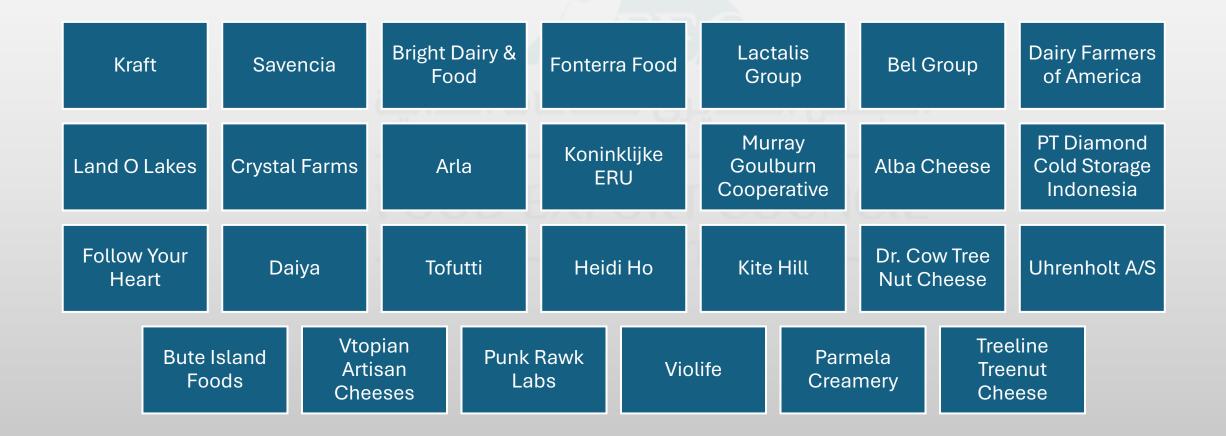

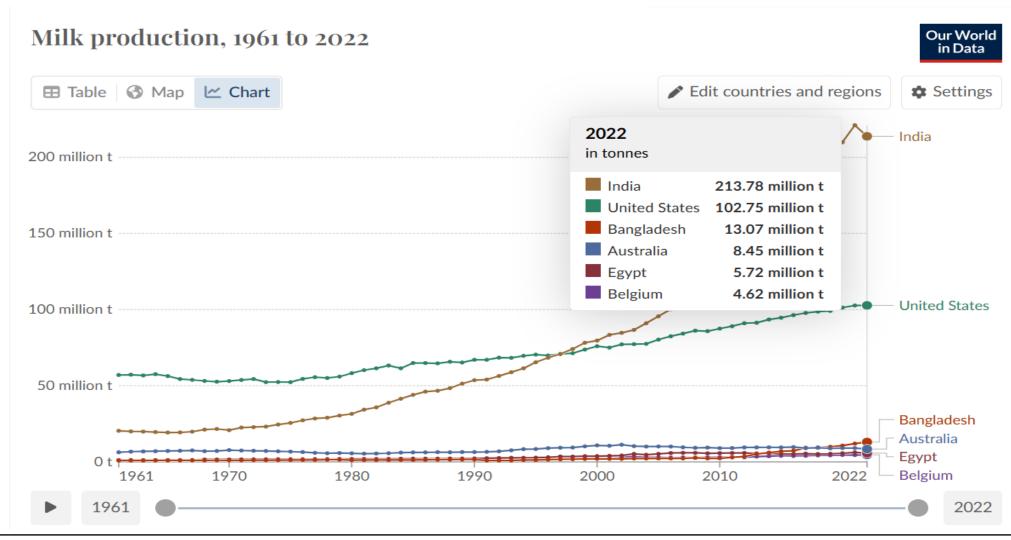


Cheese Type	Country of Orig <mark>in</mark>	Description
1. Cheddar	England	A hard, often sharp-tasting natural cheese originating from the English village of Cheddar.
2. Mozzarella	<u>Italy</u>	A traditionally southern Italian cheese made from Italian buffalo's milk by the pasta filata method.
3. <u>Brie</u>	<u>France</u>	A soft cow's-milk cheese named after Brie, the French region from which it originated.
4. Gouda	<u>Netherlands</u>	A mild, yellow cheese made from cow's milk, originating from the Netherlands.
5. <u>Swiss</u>	Switzerland	Known for its distinctive holes or "eyes", this cheese has a mild, nutty flavor.
6. Blue Cheese	Various	Characterized by blue or blue-green veins and a strong, sharp flavor.
7. Feta	Greece	A brined curd white cheese made in Greece from sheep's milk, or from a mixture of sheep and goat's milk.
8. <u>Camembert</u>	France	A moist, soft, creamy, surface-ripened cow's milk cheese from France.

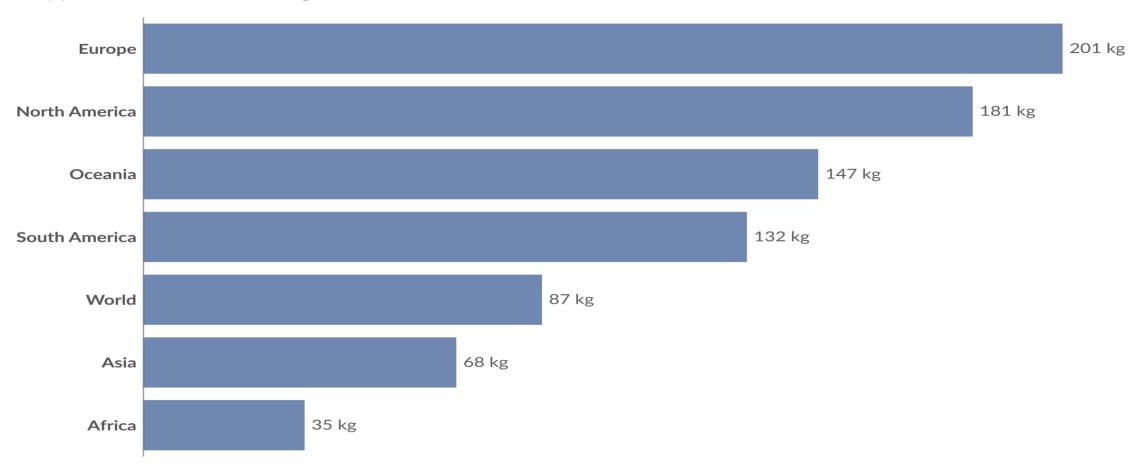
Milk consumption per person

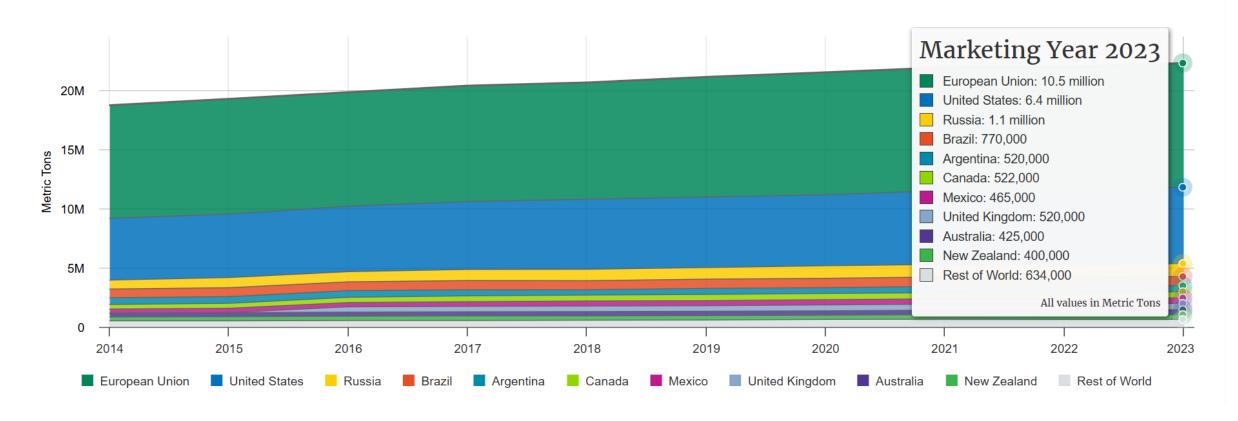

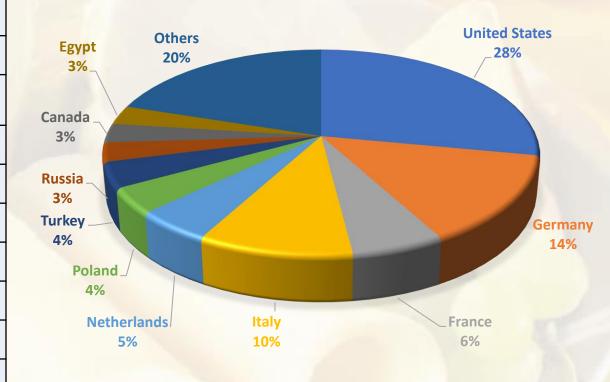

PORTION OF GLOBAL SUGAR PRODUCTION



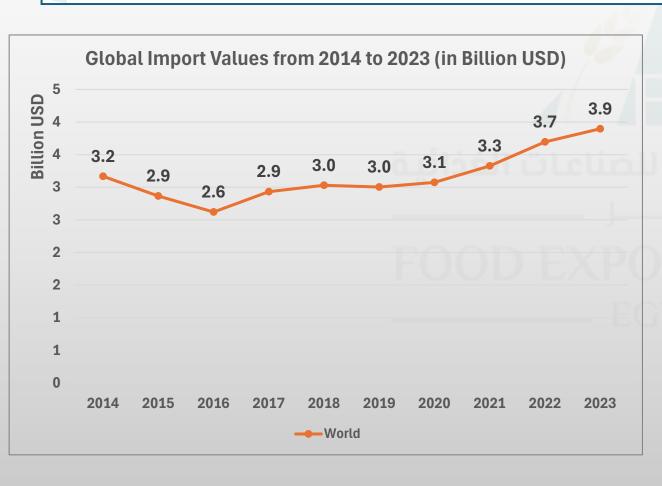
In 2023, global cheese production reached approximately 22 million metric tons.

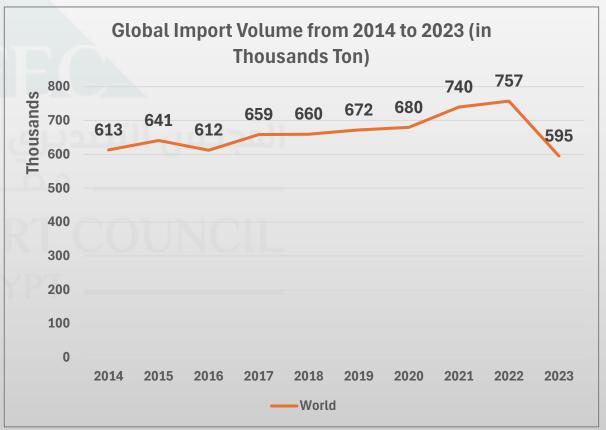
- The European Union was the largest producer, contributing 10.5 million metric tons, accounting for 47% of global production.

Global Imports and Trend Analysis HS Code 040630







Global import analysis for 2023 revealed a total import value of \$3.9 billion and a quantity of 595 thousand tons. Between 2019 and 2023, import values grew at an annual rate of 8%, while quantities increased by 2% annually. A 6% rise in value from 2022 to 2023 indicates a steady upward trend in prices during this period, with an average unit value of \$6,548.

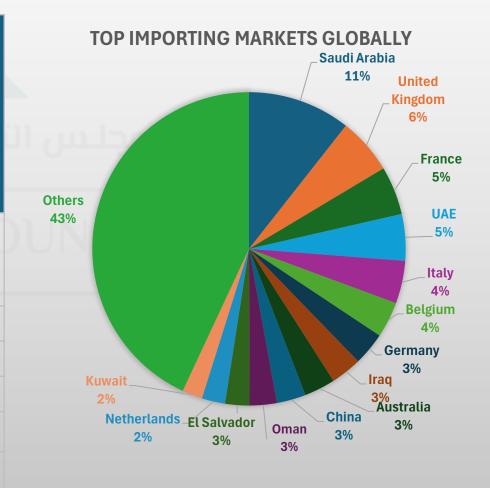

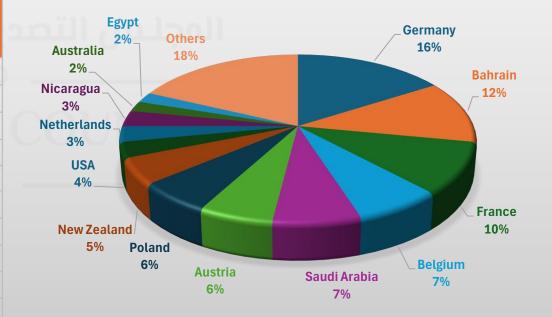

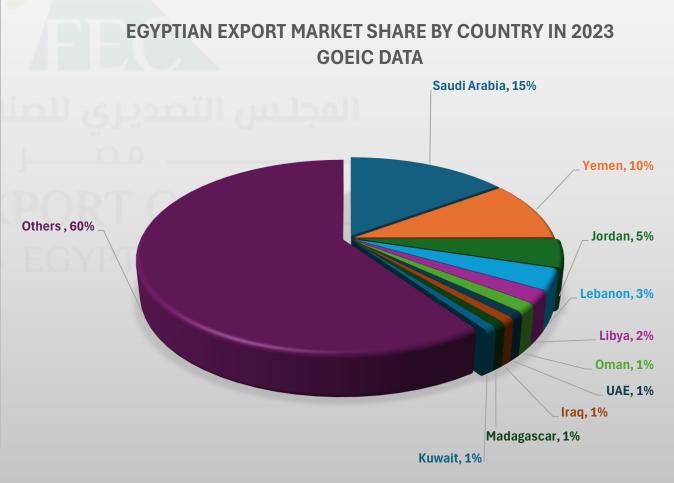
According to Trade Map, Egypt's global ranking in processed cheese exports experienced fluctuations between 2015 and 2019:

- **2018**: 5th place with \$162 million.
- **2019**: 6th place with \$136 million.

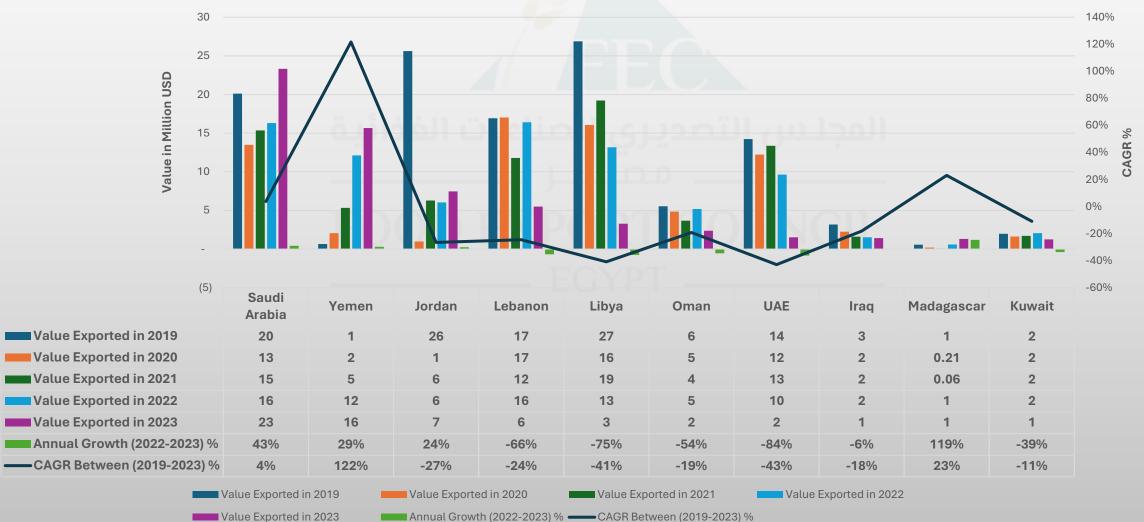

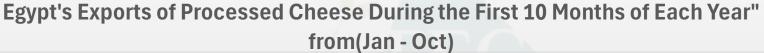

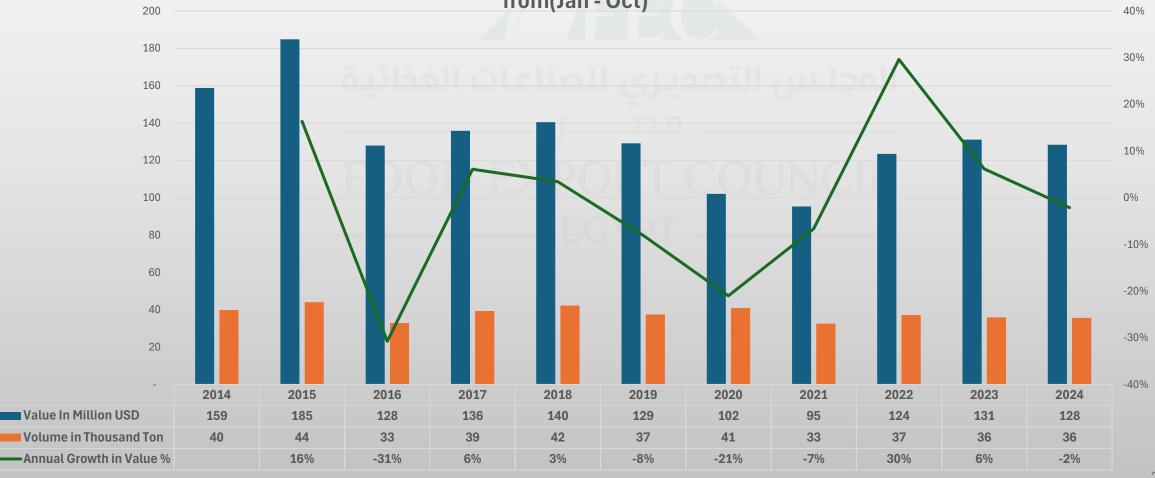




Overview of Egypt's Processed Cheese During the First 10 Months of Each Year" from(Jan - Oct)





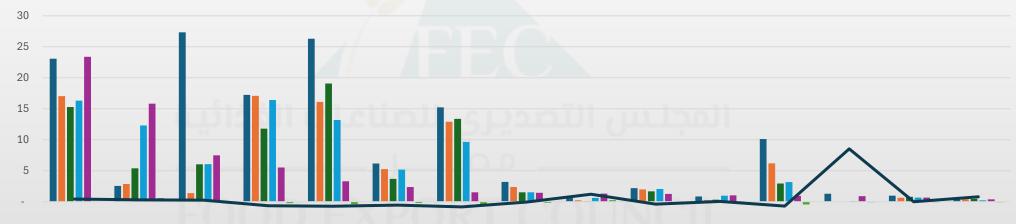

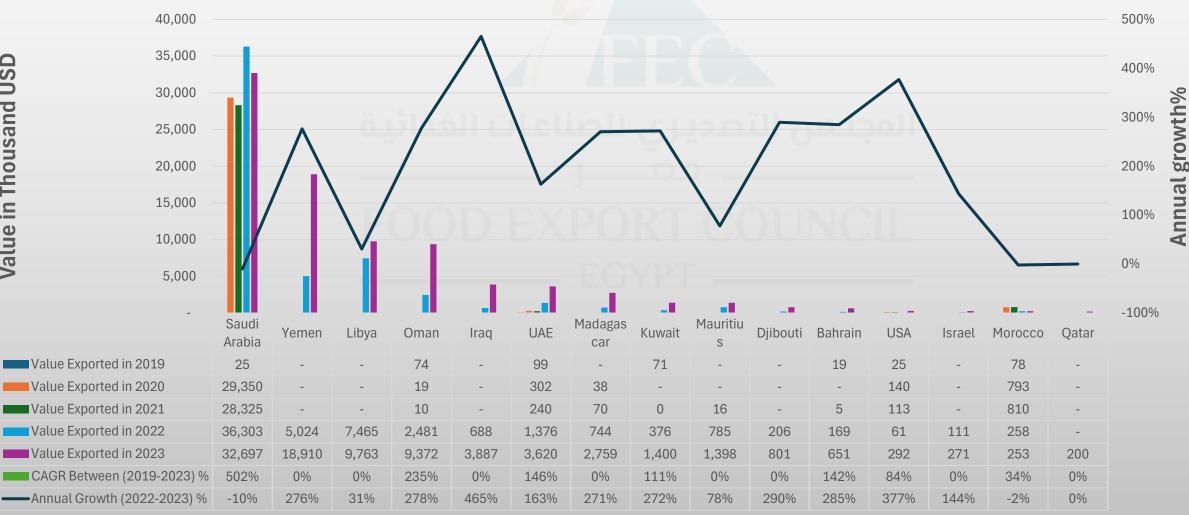

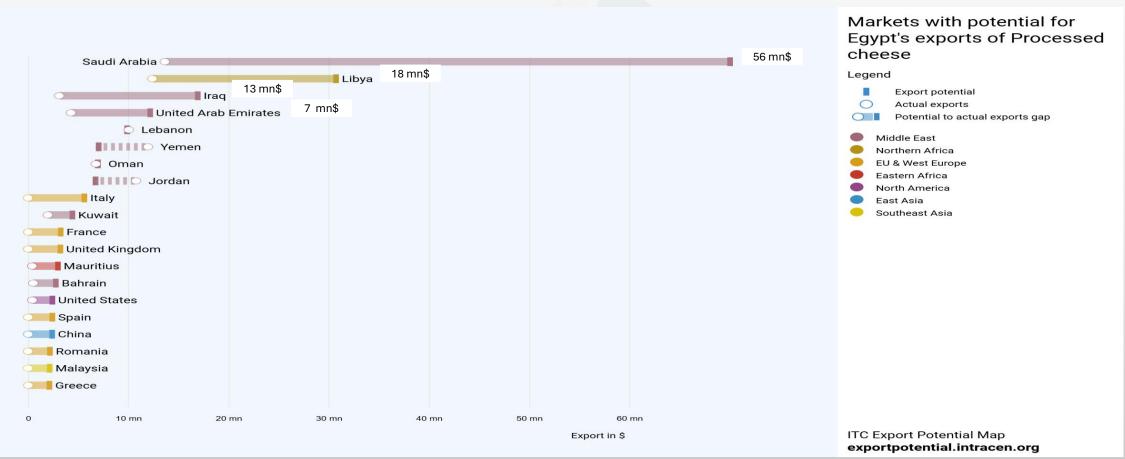


Egypt Vegetable Fat Cheese Preparations Top Export Value Destinations and Growth Trends

Key findings: The markets with greatest potential for Egypt's exports of 040630 Processed cheese are Saudi Arabia, Libya and Iraq. Saudi Arabia shows the largest absolute difference between potential and actual exports in value terms, leaving room to realize additional exports worth \$56 mn.

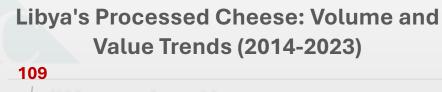

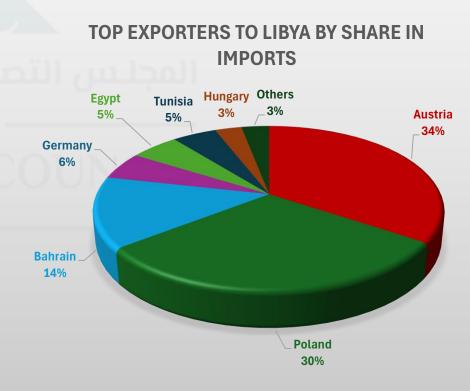

Challenges in Exporting Processed Cheese



- 1. Regulatory Compliance: Food Safety Standards:
 - Different countries have varying food safety regulations that must be adhered to. For instance, in the European Union, strict regulations govern dairy imports, including hygiene standards and labeling requirements. Non-compliance can lead to shipment rejections or delays.
 - Halal Certification: In markets like the Middle East, Halal certification is crucial for dairy products. Exporters must ensure that their products are certified to meet local religious and cultural requirements, complicating the export process.

2. Logistical Challenges

- Transportation Issues: Political instability in regions such as Libya can disrupt supply chains, leading to increased transportation costs and delays. For example, a major Egyptian exporter faced significant delays in 2022 due to road blockages, affecting delivery schedules and resulting in product spoilage.
- Cold Chain Management: Processed cheese requires proper temperature control during transportation to maintain quality. Any failure in the cold chain can lead to spoilage, impacting the product's safety and marketability.

3. Market Competition

- Local Preferences: In both Libya and Saudi Arabia, there is strong competition from local dairy producers. Egyptian exporters must differentiate their products to compete effectively. Research indicates that 60% of Libyan consumers prefer locally flavored processed cheese, necessitating product adaptation.
- Brand Loyalty: Saudi consumers often exhibit brand loyalty, with studies showing that 70% prefer local brands. This can pose a challenge for new entrants from Egypt, who must invest in marketing and brand building to gain market share.

4. Economic Factors

- Fluctuating Costs: Economic instability, particularly in Libya, can lead to fluctuating costs for raw materials and transportation. Exporters must be prepared for these variations, which can affect pricing strategies and profit margins.
- Consumer Spending Power: Changes in consumer spending power, influenced by economic conditions, can impact demand for imported products. For example, during economic downturns, consumers may prioritize cheaper local alternatives over imported processed cheese.

Conclusion



- The global processed cheese market experienced significant growth from 2019 to 2023, reaching a value of \$3.9 billion and a volume of 595 thousand tons by 2023. The market grew at an annual rate of 8% in value and 2% in volume. A 6% rise in value from 2022 to 2023 indicates a steady upward trend in prices, with an average unit value of \$6,548.
- Egypt's Contribution to the Market: In 2023, Egypt contributed \$156 million and 43 thousand tons to global processed cheese exports under HS codes 040630, 040690, and 210690. The breakdown is as follows:
 - HS Code 040630 (Processed Cheese): \$68 million, 19 thousand tons.
 - HS Code 040690 (Cooked Cheese): \$203 thousand, 64 tons.
 - HS Code 210690 (Vegetable Fat Cheese Preparations): \$87 million, 23 thousand tons.
 - Egypt ranked 12th globally, accounting for 2% of world exports for these categories.

Key Importing and Exporting Markets:

- Top Importers in 2023: Saudi Arabia led with 11% of global imports, followed by the UK (6%), France (5%), UAE (5%), Italy (4%), and Belgium (4%). These markets collectively accounted for 35% of global imports.
- Top Exporters in 2023: Germany was the largest exporter with a 17% share, followed by Bahrain (13%), France (10%), Belgium (8%), and Austria (7%). Together, these countries held 55% of global exports.



Conclusion following

Opportunities for Egypt's Exports:

- **Processed Cheese (HS Code 040630):** The largest unrealized export potential for Egypt is in Saudi Arabia, with an opportunity to increase exports by \$56 million. Other key markets with potential are Libya and Iraq.
- Food Preparations (HS Code 210690): The United States, UAE, and Libya represent the greatest unrealized export potential, with the US showing a \$48 million opportunity for Egypt.

• Market Dynamics in Key Importing Countries:

- Saudi Arabia: As the largest importer of processed cheese, Saudi Arabia imported \$320 million (59 thousand tons) in 2023. The import value grew by 15% annually from 2019 to 2023, and volume increased by 9%. However, the unit value decreased to \$5,437 per ton in 2023, though there was a 1% increase in value between 2022 and 2023.
- **Libya:** Ranking 20th globally, Libya imported \$32 million (7 thousand tons) in processed cheese in 2023. Import value grew by 2% from 2019 to 2023, while volume decreased by 3%. Between 2022 and 2023, Libya experienced a 14% increase in import value, with a unit value of \$4,483 per ton.
