


INTRODUCTION





THE EVOLUTION OF EGYPTIAN FOOD EXPORTS FROM 2014 TO 2024 VALUE IN BILLION DOLLARS











Note: India's global food imports reached nearly USD 34 billion in 2024, highlighting the country's strong and diverse demand for agricultural and processed food products.








YEARLY GROWTH TREND FROM EGYPT TO INDIA (2015-2024)

TOP 10 PRODUCTS EGYPT EXPORTED TO INDIA IN 2024



PRODUCT OVERLAP BETWEEN EGYPT AND INDIA IN FOOD SECTOR



In 2024, India imported 783 food products, while Egypt exported 434 processed and dried food products globally. Among them, only 33 Egyptian products were actually exported to India. However, there is an overlap of 335 products between what India imports and what Egypt exports, indicating strong untapped export potential for Egyptian products in the Indian market.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Target the 335 Overlapping Products

 Egypt currently exports only 33 food products to India, even though there are 335 food products that India imports and Egypt already exports worldwide.

2. Prioritize Products with High Unrealized Export Potential

- Egypt has an estimated unrealized export potential of \$65 million to India.
- Key products include spices (\$9.9M), dates (\$8.9M), yeast (\$3.1M), etc.

3. Strengthen Market Access and Visibility

Many products are globally exported and imported by India, but not yet traded between the two (e.g., wheat flour, strawberriEgyptianes, sugar, frozen vegetables).

4. Deepen Penetration in Existing Product Successes

 Products like table olives, chocolate, vinegar-preserved vegetables, and dried onions are already performing well in India.
